

Guidelines for writing the Motivation Letter

Please be as precise as you can when writing your Motivation Letter. Do not repeat yourself and **do not exceed the word limit of 1000 words**.

You should make sure that in your Motivation Letter you address the following issues:

- You should outline your motivation for choosing the TRIBOS Joint Master Programme (i.e. how it complements and develops your previous studies/professional career; how it relates to your career path; how it relates to your personal and academic interests).
- Explain why you think you are a good candidate for the programme given your previous studies/professional experience and the courses offered on the TRIBOS in both years of the Master Programme.
- You should highlight your participation at conferences, publications of your previous research, internships, summer schools, and any other professional and academic activities.
